Supervisor Steve LeGrave read agenda. Motion to approve agenda was made by Paul Dalebroux, seconded by Steve LeGrave. Motion carried.

1) Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Clerk Sarah Monfils provided the Board with minutes of the previous Town Board meeting in advance. Paul Dalebroux made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Steve LeGrave. Motion carried.

2) Reports

A) Treasurer

Ken Bouchonville read the treasurer’s report.

Paul Dalebroux made a motion to approve the treasurer’s report as presented, seconded by Steve LeGrave. Motion carried.

Ken Bouchonville shared that CD #1 is due February 25. Ken shared current rates. Paul and Steve discussed reinvesting in the 6-month CD. Paul Dalebroux made a motion to reinvest the reserve CD #1 for 6 months. Steve LeGrave seconded the motion. Motion carried.

B) Plan Commission

Jeremy Pingel read the minutes from the February Plan Commission Meeting. There was discussion about the Logan Hermans property. Paul agreed with the plan commission in that it should look more residential. Steve mentioned that the driveway needs to be wide enough. Jeremy will report back to Logan, who plans to get a redesign. There are also concerns about the width of the road.

C) County Supervisor

3) Public Input – 10 Minutes

Paul Dalebroux brought up that Abitz Ln. is flooding. Joe pushed removed snow with the excavator and solved the problem.

Steve LeGrave brought up stumps on Rendezvous Rd. by the bridge. Joe plans to look at it when he does Rendezvous Rd. tree cutting, which is the last road he has to get done.

Joe reported that he was unable to find the concern Jeff Dorner inquired about on Bader Rd.

4) New Business

A) WTA Board of Review Certification

Steve and Paul attended the meeting. They talked about small bridge structures and a potential state grant. The clerk has to fill it out and Marty Trembl said he would be available to help. Steve and Paul are going to review the list to make sure they know what structures they would like to apply for funding to improve before moving forward with the application.

B) HVAC Maintenance Contract Review & Approval

Kinnard sent a quote but the Wolf Brothers quote was not available for review.

Paul Dalebroux made a motion to table it until next month when we have both bids. Steve LeGrave seconded. Motion carried.

C) Brush Cutting / Tree Cutting Update

D) Town Road Update, Maintenance Issue

A bid from Dennis Haumschild to get things up to fire code was presented. Paul Dalebroux made a motion to accept the estimate of \$1023.00. Steve LeGrave seconded. Motion carried.

Steve brought up getting bids for replacing windowsills, siding, and insulation. Paul agreed we should put it out to bid for this spring.

The electrical issues were also brought up but there was no update.

E) Town Clerk Update

i) Website update

We are up and running. There was a slight glitch with our .gov emails in the process but everything has been resolved. Sarah will train with Suzi soon.

ii) Apply for State Grants

This was discussed with the WTA Board updates. Sarah will work with the board and Marty to complete the application for the bridge grant.
